

# **Mission Statement**

Our Lady of Grace, founded in 1910 as an Italian ethnic parish, is now a territorial parish of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Greensburg to which all people are welcome. The responsibility of each member of Our Lady of Grace is to hear the Word of God and live it by sharing in worship, especially at Eucharist; by nurturing our Catholic faith through formation and prayer; by reaching out to identify and serve the needs of our parish and the community; and by welcoming others into our faith community. Through our actions, we strive to share, and to encourage others to share, in the fullness of God's kingdom.

#### **Baptisms**

By appointment only. Please call the parish office at least four months in advance of the birth. A class for parents is required to reflect on the meaning of the sacrament, to review the ceremony, and to highlight the importance of the family's commitment to practicing the Catholic Faith.

#### Sponsorship Forms

Forms for our members to serve as sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation must be filled out in person at the Parish Office. To serve as a sponsor, you must be at least 16 years old and a practicing Catholic who has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you are married, it must be within the guidelines of the Catholic Church. Please call the Parish Office to make an appointment to fill out the form.

#### Weddings

Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance.

Do not set a date until you have contacted the parish priest. Pre-marriage preparation classes are required and are available in a couple of forms.

August Food Pantry collection ~ We sincerely appreciate all who responded to the July food pantry collection. We received 710 items, which were in turn, distributed to our clients. It is difficult to properly express the appreciation of those who receive the additional items each month. As we approach the beginning of the school year, let us be mindful of our young children. Kid-friendly items such as peanut butter and jelly, cereal, fruit cups, pudding cups, and granola bars are always helpful when packing lunches. Other items for our families that are needed include pasta items and canned goods, as well as meats. In addition, soaps, paper products, personal hygiene items and diapers are always needed. In advance, we want to thank you for considering a donation to this worthwhile project on August 26 and 27, as well as your continued prayers for those who are in need in our community. May God bless you for your continued support and generosity! Please remember that we are unable to distribute any items that are out of date.

The combined collection for the Catholic University of America and our diocesan Catholic schools will take place next weekend, August 26-27. This year, 50 percent of this collection will go to support The Catholic University and 50 percent will be used to aid the Catholic schools here in our own diocese. The Catholic University of America's mission is to prepare future leaders for the Church and the nation who are formed in the Catholic tradition that faith and the intellectual life enhance each other. Like The Catholic University, our Catholic schools are an asset of the community that prepare future leaders for the church and the nation.

Carrying the Gifts: One of the beautiful customs we have at Our Lady of Grace is that the family of the person for whom the particular weekend Mass is being offered may honor the memory of that person by carrying the offertory gifts of bread and wine, along with the free-will offering of our parishioners, to the altar. This is an honor because it represents our parish family pre-

senting to God the gifts necessary for not only the family celebration of the liturgy, but the ongoing work of our parish family. Upon arriving for Mass, those wishing to accept this opportunity should notify the ushers who are at the entrance of the church. If the ushers are not notified before Mass, they are not sure if any of the family or friends are present to carry the gifts.


