# Pastor's Notes:

### **Catechetical Sunday**

The American Church observes Catechetical Sunday today. It marks the beginning of Faith Formation (formerly known as CCD) classes in most parishes. But it is much more than this, it is a day to celebrate the gift of faith which we have received and are all called to hand on to the next generation. Those who volunteer to be part of this critical and important work of the church are truly ministers of the Gospel of Jesus and today we all thank you and pray for you as you begin a new year. The faith is passed on not just by teaching but by example and prayer so even if we are not in the classroom all of us are handing on the faith by the way we live. The catechetical work of the church extends beyond the teaching of our children to other ministries, in particular the RCIA. This ministry is the process by which an adult (confirmation age and older) who is not baptized or has not made First Communion or Confirmation are welcomed into the full life of the church. Joining with others who are on the same journey, we discuss, explore and imbibe the meaning of the gospels, the traditions of the church and the challenge of living a Christian life. We are also preparing to become involved in a new youth ministry process called "Vital 3" which is aimed at going beyond classes to inviting our young people to become disciples by knowing Jesus and living by His ways. We need your prayers for all of these ministries. Catechetical Sunday is good day to start.
