Pastor's Notes:

Mission Sunday

On the third Sunday of October each year, the church celebrates mission Sunday. It is the day when the church focuses on the mission of the church to spread the Gospel to the ends of the earth. It is a day when we are asked to support the works of the propagation of the faith and aid those men and women who are laboring in foreign lands. In today's world, much of the work they do is to first bring healing and hope to the people before they even make mention of God and the Gospel.
