NEW RAMP FOR THE OFFICE CENTER

Construction began this week for a new handicap accessible ramp for the front door of the parish office center. This has become a necessity because the present was just about to collapse. We knew that this was a need and have been saving for it for the past couple of years. It will be paid for completely out of the last two years food and fuel raffle and supplemented by the present years and from savings if necessary. It is being built out of TREK, a composite material that doesn't require maintenance. During this construction, the front door of the office will be closed and so you will need to use the side door on the back porch for business (hopefully, only this week). Again we thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we strive to make our office a safe and efficient place to serve you.

We are still working on the aftermath of the fire. It has been decided to remove all the blown insulation from the attic since it still had the smell of fire in it even after the cleaning. It will also give us a chance to clean out a lot of junk that has accumulated over the years. This will be paid for by the insurance settlement and the cleaning out will be done by the staff.
