Thanks be to You, Lord of the harvest for the abundance of the fruits of the earth and the bounty of the sea with which You feed us, Your Children.


Thanks be to You, Creator of heaven and earth for clement weather and peaceful times and the labor of farmers and field hands who fill our table with Your blessings.
