LENT: Good Friday March 30th, we are asked to fast and abstain from meat. Fasting means not to eat between meals and that our two smaller meals must be less than our one main meal. There is a limit of one full meal on these day for all between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive. This, of course, is excused for medical reasons and another act of sacrifice is to be substituted. All Fridays in Lent, we are asked to abstain from meat totally and this applies to those who have reached their 14th year.

Little Black Books: Our little black Lenten reflection books are available at both entrance ways to church. Pick up a book and enjoy spending a few extra moments with the Lord in prayer.
