

REMINDER: Lenten Regulations for Fast and Abstinence: Good Friday April 14th, we are asked to fast and abstain from meat. Fasting means not to eat between meals and that our two smaller meals must be less than our one main meal. For medical reasons another act of sacrifice can be substituted. All Fridays in Lent, we are asked to abstain from meat totally and this applies to those who have reached their 14th year.

St. Patrick-Providence Agape 2017: Agape is the biblical Greek word for self-sacrificing love. That's the love God displayed for the world by sending His Son to die on the cross for mankind, and the love that is characteristic among His church. First century Christians participated in Agape feasts as an expression of the deep personal relationships they shared with one another and in obedience to Jesus' command to, "Do this in remembrance of Me" found in Luke 22. While Agape feasts were the norm for the first 300 years of the church's existence, this intimate gathering became less common after Constantine embraced Christianity and began the process of constructing buildings to accommodate large Christian gatherings. This effectively moved the church out of the home and into a more formal environment.
