MARCH 25, 2018 PALM SUNDAY

Dear Brothers and Sister,

With the celebration of the Palm Sunday we enter into the Holy Week. The Days between Palm Sunday and Holy Thursday are known as Holy Monday, Holy Tuesday and Holy Wednesday.

On Monday, we observe the anointing of Jesus at Bethany.

On Tuesday, we observe Jesus' prediction about his own death.

On Wednesday, we observe the story of Judas arranging his betrayal of Jesus with the High Priests.

On the Holy Thursday or Maundy Thursday, we commemorate the institution of the Holy Eucharist, the institution of the Priesthood and the commandment of Love that Jesus gave after the washing of the feet of his disciples.

On the Good Friday, the mourns the death of Christ, revere the cross and marvels at his life for obedience until death.

On Holy Saturday the Church waits at the Lord's tomb in prayer and fasting, meditating on his Passion and Death and on his Descent into Hell, and awaiting his Resurrection.

The Church abstains from the Sacrifice of the Mass, with the sacred table left bare, until after the solemn Vigil, that is, the anticipation by night of the Resurrection, when the time comes for paschal joys.

The Easter Vigil consists of four parts.

- 1. The Service of Light
- 2. The Liturgy of the Word
- 3. The Liturgy of Baptism: The sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation for new members of the Church and the Renewal of Baptismal Promises by the entire congregation.
- 4. Holy Eucharist

I want to invite you to partake in these liturgies most reverently and draw upon the grace and blessings of this Holy Week.
