All Fridays in Lent, we are asked to abstain from meat totally and this applies to those who have reached their 14th year.

NEWS FROM RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The month of April is the last full month of religious education for the school year. It is also a very busy month with Holy Week and Easter. We will be holding classes on Palm Sunday this year, but not on Easter Sunday. On Palm Sunday, the 5th grade class will be performing the Stations of the Cross in the church during the K-4 religious education class period. All parishioners are invited to watch with the religious education students.

The older students (grades 5-8) will participate in a Seder meal during their class period on April 2nd. They will have the opportunity to sample the traditional symbolic food on the Seder plate and hear the story of the Passover as related in the Haddish or script.

Our freshmen made their Confirmation at Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral on March 11th. Please see the group photo in this issue of the Shamrock. Their individual photos are on display in the hall.

At the end of this month, Sunday, April 30th, our second graders will make their First Eucharist. They and their parents will be in retreat the day before and will have an opportunity to practice before the actual day of First Communion. Until then, they will be completing their instruction and making their banners, which will be displayed in church. Their photos are displayed in the church hall. Please pray for these children as they prepare to receive the Body and Blood of Jesus for the first time.

Although official religious education classes end on May 7th, the 6th graders are still hoping to make a field trip to Our Lady Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral. Last year this was a wonderful time for the students and their parents.

Lastly, I encourage all parents to bring their children to experience the beautiful liturgy of Holy Week. We can teach about the Triduum in class, but it is always more meaningful to experience it.

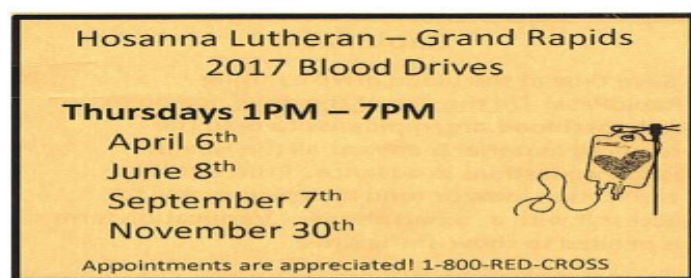

While Agape feasts were the norm for the first 300 years of the church's existence, this intimate gathering became less common after Constantine embraced Christianity and began the process of constructing buildings to accommodate large Christian gatherings. This effectively moved the church out of the home and into a more formal environment.

Please join us in the hall after the Holy Thursday liturgy for a celebration of love or Agape! Traditionally this celebration might have included bread, wine and grapes, and a light meal; so we will try to celebrate as our ancestors did. 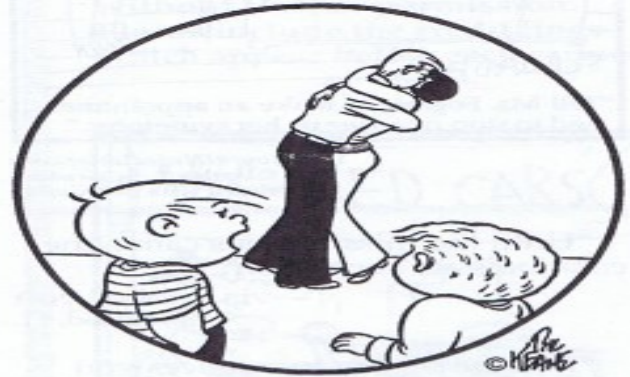
"Building His Church, Fulfilling His Mission"

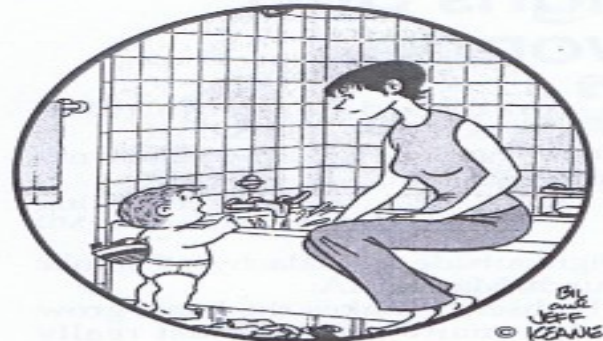

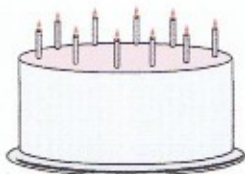

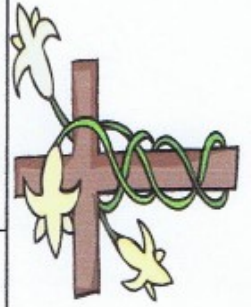
