Chief Special Warfare Operator Ed Byers recently received the Medal of Honor from President Barak Obama. The navy seal was awarded the medal for his heroic acts while on a mission to rescue an American hostage in December 2012, who had been captured by the Taliban. The Medal of Honor is the highest military honor. Byers is the first living sailor to be awarded the Medal of Honor since 1988. Ed was baptized here at St. Pat's.
