

Invitation: Spend some time alone, handing over your worries and concerns to God's Love- trusting, like a child, that you will be led to make the most peaceful, loving, reconciling action. Make a "NEW YOU" resolution.

Prayer: Inviting One, I thank you for your care to clothe me and bless me each day with your compassion and love. I ask for your daily blessing of my comings and goings as I seek to bring these graces to all I meet.

Personal challenge: Add to your daily ritual of readying yourself for the day by turning your welcome mat around or blessing yourself on your way.


