FROM THE RECYCLING COMMITTEE

Royal Oak Recycling has reported that during the period October 2014 to June 2015, 30,312 pounds (15.16 tons) of recycled materials were collected for a rebate amount of \$75.78. Since there was a delay in the processing of our reimbursement, the company has doubled our rebate amount and sent us a check for \$151.56. We are averaging about \$20.00 a quarter for our recycling efforts.



BLESSED JUNIPERO SERRA CANONIZED A SAINT



While on his visit to the U.S. this past week, Pope Francis presided at the canonization of **Blessed Junipero Serra**, at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C., on **September 23.** The first saint to be canonized in the United States, he was born in 1713 on the island of Majorca off the coast of Spain.

Fr. Serra set sail from Majorca in 1749 and after almost two months at sea, he and other missionaries arrived in Puerto Rico. He traveled on to Veracruz, Mexico, walked 250 miles to Mexico City and eventually made his way to San Diego. He founded nine missions in California before dying in Carmel in 1784. St. Junipero Serra is the patron of the Serra Clubs, an international organization with 6 clubs in the Cleveland Diocese, which foster and promote vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
