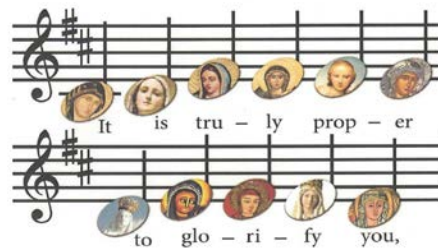

CINEMA POLSKA COURSE

There will be an introduction to the film by Dr. Markiewka (and special guests) and discussion will follow after the film.
