Please join us on **Sunday, February 28** in the
Parish Hall immediately following the 9:00 a.m.
Mass to pack personal care kits for the clients
at Catholic West Side Center and the **Metanoia
Project** at the St. Malachi Campus.

Metanoia is a Greek word meaning a change in mind, a change
in one's way of life resulting from penitence or spiritual
conversion. It implies making a decision to turn around, to face a
new direction. The **Metanoia Project at St. Malachi's** is a
program designed to provide food, clothing, shelter, showers and
resources to the homeless. Homeless men and women of our
city (especially the shelter resistant, living under bridges, in
alleyways, and on park benches) are welcomed and gathered.
They are provided with hot meals, showers, clothing, hygiene
and overnight hospitality. Open 4 nights a week (Friday,
Saturday, Sunday & Monday) 7:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m. in the old St.
Malachi School located at 2459 Washington Ave in Cleveland,
the program runs from mid-November thru April.
