GOD IS THE TRINITY

The **mystery of the Holy Trinity** is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others.

Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

All Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity illumines all the other mysteries of faith.

CHURCH RESTORATION & REPAIR

On Tuesday of this past week, work was begun on the repair and restoration of the ceiling above the side entrance in front of



the altar of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The work is being done by **Eikona Studios** of Tremont. The whole project will include patching and painting the ceiling in this area as well as a part of the arch above the downstairs organ, replacing a *corbel*, (the support bracket that juts out of the wall near the BVM altar) and restoring the medallion above the chandelier lighting.

There are 5 medallions in the church – each one is different. The one being replaced is pictured to the right as it appeared in 2010. This medallion was damaged due to the water leak in the ceiling. A replica of the medallion will be created and installed above the light fixture.



MEMORIAL DAY MASS

Monday, May 30, is Memorial Day. This year the day happens to coincide with the date of May 30 which for many years was observed as the traditional date for Memorial Day at St. Barbara's Church. At the 9:00 a.m. Mass we will read the names of the men listed on our memorial monument as we light candles for them. We hope you will be able to join us for this commemoration.
