Those who perform the spiritual and corporal works of mercy may also, by their actions, obtain the Jubilee Indulgence. The Holy Father states, "Each time that one of the faithful personally performs one or more of the works of mercy, he or she shall surely obtain the Jubilee Indulgence."



UPDATE ON RECENT RESTORATION & REPAIRS

- Work to repair and restore parts of the church that were damaged due to water leaks was completed last week.
 The ceiling near the altar of the Blessed Virgin Mary, part of the arch above the downstairs organ and an area above St. Barbara's altar were all patched and painted. A corbel, (the support bracket that juts out of the wall near the BVM altar) was replaced and a new medallion above the chandelier lighting was created and installed. This project was made possible by a \$10,000 gift from an Anonymous Benefactor.
- New glass block windows and vents were added to the church so that now all the basement windows are glass block. The cost of \$4,500 was provided by the
 St. Barbara Parish Guild through their fundraising events.
- Payment for roof repairs to the parish garage amounting to \$500 was made possible by your donations to the Maintenance Fund.

Thanks to everyone who supports our Church and helps to keep it in good repair.
