Groups meet monthly offering an opportunity to those who come to listen and share community, network and learn from others who understand their situation, challenges, fears and emotions. All are welcome to participate irrespective of faith affiliation. No preregistration is necessary.

Begun in the Diocese in 2014, the **LEAF** Program now has 8 meeting sites including one nearby at **Mary Queen of Peace Church**, 4423 Pearl Road. The meetings at Mary Queen of Peace are held on the **fourth Wednesday of the month** in the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. and are usually concluded by 9:00
