NEXT WEEKEND: Special Collection for Louisiana Flood Victims

The Catholic Diocese of Cleveland and dioceses across the country have been asked by the leadership of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops to have an emergency collection to assist victims of the recent flooding in Louisiana.

The storms in Louisiana caused the worst flooding since Hurricane Karina. As many as 60,000 homes have been damaged, with nearly 20,000 people being rescued from the flood waters. More than 106,000 individuals and families have sought federal disaster relief.

In support of this major relief effort this special collection will take place on the weekend of September 17-18. The funds will support the humanitarian efforts of the Catholic Charities USA and will help provide support to Catholic dioceses also impacted.
