**Sixty-two parishioners** were anointed last weekend at the Anointing Masses. May they experience God's grace, strength and peace through the reception of this sacrament.

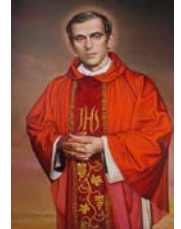

## NEWS FROM ROME

**Catholic World News** reports that Pope Francis paid tribute to **Father Jerzy Popieluszko**, the "Solidarity priest" whose feast day the Church celebrated on October 19. Father Popieluszko "personally expounded the cause of workers and their families, asking for justice and dignified living conditions, civil liberty and the religious freedom for his homeland," the Pope recalled. He reminded the audience of the Polish priest's motto, taken from St. Paul: "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."



Father Popieluszko, a highly visible supporter of the Solidarity labor movement, was kidnapped on October 19, 1984; his battered body was found in a reservoir nearly two weeks later. Four agents of the Polish secret-police force were convicted of the killing. More than 400,000 people attended his funeral.

Father Popieluszko was beatified in 2010. A miracle attributed to his intercession has subsequently been reported; it confirmed it would fulfill the requirements for his canonization.

On October 15, Pope Francis presided over Holy Mass for the **canonization of seven new Saints:**

**José Sánchez del Río**, martyr, a 14-year-old Mexican boy who was killed in 1928 opposing anti-Catholic and anticlerical government policies.

**Salomone Leclercq**, the first martyr belonging to the La Salle Order, killed in 1792 during the French Revolution.

**José Gabriel del Rosario Brochero**, 19<sup>th</sup> century Argentinean priest who brought consolation and Jesus' message of salvation to the poorest of the poor.

**Manuel González García**, Bishop of Palencia, Spain, was founder of the Congregation of the Eucharistic Missionaries of Nazareth, the Disciples of Saint John, and the Children of Reparation. He died in 1940.

**Father Lodovico Pavoni** of Brescia, Italy, the 19<sup>th</sup> century founder of the Sons of Mary Immaculate (Pavonians) believed that improving social conditions would improve the spiritual life, and improving the spiritual life would improve social conditions.

**Alfonso Maria Fusco**, a priest from Salerno, Italy, founder of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. John the Baptist, (Baptistine Sisters) who worked to evangelize, educate and promote youth, especially the most poor and abandoned.

**Elizabeth of the Trinity**, the French Discalced Carmelite mystic and writer died at age 26 in 1906 from Addison's disease. She gratefully accepted her suffering as a gift from God.
