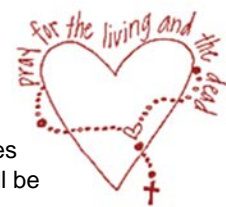

According to statistics from the **Center for Applied Research for the Apostolate**, as of 2015 there were 37,578 Catholic priests in the U.S. and 414,313 worldwide. The number of parishes without a resident priest pastor: 3,533.

**In our Diocese** there are currently 80 young men studying for the priesthood at the Diocese of Cleveland seminaries. Eight of these young men were ordained as deacons by Bishop Richard Lennon on Saturday, October 22 at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist. They will continue their studies and formation for priestly ministry. Seven will be ordained for service to the Diocese of Cleveland. One was called by the archbishop of the Archdiocese of Daegu, South Korea, for service there.

On **November 9** Catholic parishes across Ohio, including the Cathedral and nearby parishes of St. Rocco and Mary Queen of Peace, will be offering Eucharistic Adoration for vocations. In addition to thanking our parish priests this year, remember to **pray for more vocations** to the priesthood.
