JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY COMES TO A CLOSE



The **Jubilee Year of Mercy** officially ends this Sunday November 20, the Solemnity of Christ the King, when Pope Francis will close the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica. It was opened on Dec. 8, 2015, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.

With the closing of Holy doors in Catholic churches and basilicas around the world, including in Rome, it is estimated that more than 20 million people participated in the church's **Jubilee Year of Mercy** at the Vatican and a billion people may have participated in churches worldwide.
