ST. ALBERT CHMIELOWSKI



At the conclusion of his general audience on January 11, Pope Francis paid tribute to **St. Albert Chmielowski**, a Polish Third Order Franciscan who died on Christmas Day in 1916.

Born in Igolomia near Kraków as the eldest of four children in a wealthy family, he was christened Adam. His great talent for painting led to studies in Warsaw, Munich, and Paris. Adam returned to

Kraków and became a Secular Franciscan. In 1888, he took the name Albert when he founded the Brothers of the Third Order of Saint Francis, Servants to the Poor. They worked primarily with the homeless, depending completely on alms while serving the needy, regardless of age, religion, or politics. A community of Albertine sisters was established later.

In 1949, the future Pope St. John Paul II wrote ***Our God's Brother***, a play about the saint. In 1983, Pope John Paul beatified Albert Chmielowski and canonized him in 1989.

"In the Church of Poland, this year is dedicated to Brother Albert Chmielowski, on the centenary of his death," Pope Francis said. "Following the example of this great saint of mercy, brother and defender of the homeless, the poor and the marginalized, let us take love, charity and hope to all those who are in need."
