### Sacred Triduum

Originally, there was no Holy Week. The **Pascha** (another name for **Easter**, the word comes from the Jewish word for "Passover") was celebrated in the context of a single day: the Easter Vigil. It began with sunset on the Sabbath evening and continued until dawn on the first day of the week or Sunday. By the fifth century, this Paschal Mystery had been broken down into its historical pieces, partly under the influence of borrowing from Jerusalem. The nucleus was called the **Sacred Triduum** (Latin for "three days"): Friday until Easter morning. It remembered the death, burial and resurrection. Later Holy Thursday was included because all days were reckoned from sunset of the previous evening (as was the Jewish tradition).
