### MAINTENANCE UPDATE: Church Lighting Project

The light bulbs throughout the church have been replaced with updated bulbs that give as much and even more light and use less power. The light fixtures for the altar area have been completely replaced so that the spotlights illuminate the altar, the tabernacle, the crucifix, and statues far better. The fixtures were made by the ingenuity of our electrician.



The whole project would have cost some \$10,000 if done by an electrical engineering company but instead it cost us just around \$4,000 which covered the cost of labor, materials, scaffolding and all the new light bulbs and spots. *Thank you Electrician David Kowal.*
