Fr. Martello is a "local boy" having grown up in Cleveland (St. Stephen parish) and Parma Heights (Holy Family & St. John Bosco). He was ordained a priest on May 31, 1970. Fr. Martello was a teacher of philosophy for 30 years in the Ft. Wayne, Ind., area; in the Crosier Seminary in Onamia; and at Holy Cross College in Mulo, Democratic Republic of the Congo. Since 2006, he has helped raise funds for the Crosiers in Congo, and has provided pastoral assistance for parishes in Minnesota.

Fr. Martello will be here before the English Masses on Saturday and Sunday to hear confessions.
