We received a notice this week that it will soon be time for the **Status Animarum 2016-2017**. This yearly report for the Diocese lists our activities and statistics for the year including the number of registered parishioners.

If you are attending our church on a regular basis and/or are contributing **please register** so that you can be part of the "count". Remember you can always be registered at more than one parish. As of today 200 families are registered. (325 individual members)
