### CENTENNIAL STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA

To mark the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady's appearance in Fatima, Portugal, in 1917, Pope Francis has blessed 6 statues of Our Lady of Fatima, one for each continent, so that they can be sent into each of the 6 continents for public veneration and to stimulate devotion to Our Lady.

The statue is making its pilgrim way around the United States and will be visiting St. Barbara's on **Sunday, September 3**. It will arrive at our church at **12:00 Noon** and be with us until 4:30 when it will travel next to St. Basil the Great parish. While the statue is here there will be devotions, reciting the litany and an act of consecration. We will pray the rosary and sing Marian hymns. Everyone is invited to bring flowers. More information will be forthcoming.



The mission of each statue of Our Lady of Fatima is to reawaken the Christian Faith in our land, to bring souls to Christ, in particular through recourse to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
