SECOND COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND: Statue of St. John Paul II

THIS WEEKEND we will have a special second collection for the statue of St. John Paul II that will be added to the Polish Garden oft the Cultural Gardens of Cleveland. For years to come and in a public place, this bust will be a concrete statement of our regard for this Pope of Polish ancestry and the greatness of his work as leader of the Catholic Church. With our contribution, St. Barbara will be



among the parishes whose names will be inscribed on the base on which the bust will rest. The bust is an excellent representation of the pontiff with his miter (the bishop's headdress) and crosier (the bishop's staff). Please be generous.

MAINTENANCE UPDATE: Your Maintenance Fund Money at Work

Work on the rear parking lot on West 15th Street has been completed. All asphalt surfaces were thoroughly cleaned and 2 coats of asphalt based pavement sealer were applied. Pavement was painted with stripes and markings to match existing layout and color scheme. Cost: \$1,245.

Late last Sunday evening part of the large tree on the West 16th Street tree lawn, splintered and fell onto the fence and into the parking lot, taking down with it the AT&T phone lines. The rectory was without phone and internet service for two days. The City of Cleveland Urban Forestry crews came out on Monday to remove the fallen limbs and branches and to cut down the rest of the tree. AT&T worked on repairing and reconnecting the phone lines. Thankfully, no one was hurt. Damage to the fence will be repaired.
