FINANCE COUNCIL NEWS

The **PARISH FINANCE COUNCIL** met on Tuesday, July 25. Present at the meeting were Pat Gannon, Mary Jean Farren, David Rubis and Ken Krol. Joyce Gibson was not able to attend. Fr. Hilinski called the meeting to order and presented a number of areas of discussion. With the contractor about to commence putting new roofs on the convent and the parish house this summer of 2017 (total cost is \$34,500), we ought to think about the future projects.

In the summer of 2018 we need to do **tuck-pointing** on the church. The north face was done when the bell tower and front of the church were illuminated with the special lighting. So we need to do the rest of the church or possibly plan do segments of the project over the next couple of summers. This would make the work easier to pay for. The Facilities Department of the Diocese has been contacted to get some reliable contractors, so that we can start to begin to determine the cost of this project.

In addition, mention was made of the **stained glass windows**. They need to be checked since sometimes bits of caulking breaks off from the windows when closing or opening them. The lead that holds the colored panes in place also needs to be maintained.

Lastly, concern was raised about the **boilers** in all the buildings (church, convent, and parish house) which are close to the end of their life. Right now the heating and cooling company has not indicated any serious concerns so hopefully we can still get some years out of the current boilers by making sure they are well maintained.
