MASS FOR THE ASSUMPTION, Tuesday, August 15

We celebrate the Solemnity of the **Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary** on **Tuesday, August 15**. This solemnity is a holy day of obligation this year. There there will be **Mass at 6:00 p.m. in Polish** and **Mass at 7:00 p.m. in English**. Fr. Knapik will be the Presider at the Polish Mass and Fr. Damian Ezeani will be Presider at the English Mass. There will be **no morning Mass** on Tuesday.



In Poland the Feast of the Assumption is also called **Matki Boski Zielnej – Blessed Mother of the Herbs** or **Our Lady of the Herbs**. Bouquets of flowers (bukiety kwiatów) and herbs (ziola) are brought to the church for a blessing. We would like to continue the tradition so we invite everyone coming to the Polish Mass on Tuesday to bring a small bouquet of flowers and herbs.

THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

The Catholic Church teaches that the Virgin Mary "having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." This doctrine was defined by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950. Whether or not Mary experienced a physical death has not been dogmatically defined by the Church. We celebrate the feast of the Assumption of Mary on August 15 as a holy day of obligation.

Eastern Catholics celebrate on the same date (August 15) the feast of the Dormition of the Theotokos ("the falling asleep of the God-bearer.") This Eastern Catholic tradition holds that Mary experienced a natural death, upon which her soul was received by Christ. On the third day after her death, her tomb was found empty. Mary has passed beyond death and judgement, and lives wholly in the Age to Come. The Resurrection of the Body has in her case been anticipated and is already an accomplished fact. That does not mean, however, that she is dissociated from the rest of humanity and placed in a wholly different category: for we all hope to share one day in that same glory of the Resurrection of the Body which she enjoys even now.

INTERNATIONAL CENTENNIAL STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA, COMES TO ST. BARBARA CHURCH, Sunday, September 3

In commemoration of this year's Centennial Anniversary, a statue of Our Lady of Fatima blessed by Pope Francis will arrive at St. Barbara's before the 9:00 a.m. Mass on **Sunday September 3**. After the Mass we will recite the rosary and sing Marian hymns in English. After the 11:00 a.m. Polish Mass we will have prayers and hymns in Polish. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be at 3:00 p.m. This will be followed by a quiet time for personal prayer and reflection until the statue is taken up for its journey to the next parish.
