## NAMASZCZENIE CHORYCH

**W sobote i niedziele, 28 i 29 października** w Kościele sw. Barbary będzie udzielany sakrament Namaszczania chorych podczas Mszy sw. po homilii. Osoby starsze, powyżej 70 lat, poważnie chore, przed operacją, osoby w podeszłym wieku mogą przyjąć Komunię sw. i Sakrament Namaszczania.

Ryt Namaszczania poucza nas że nie trzeba czekać aż na ostatni moment przed śmiercią żeby przyjąć ten Sakrament. Roztropność dyktuje nam kiedy mamy przyjąć Namaszczanie. Sakrament może być powtórzony jeśli stan chorego się pogorszył, powinien każdy przyjąć Namaszczanie przed operacją, zawsze kiedy się w słabej kondycji, chociaż nie zagraża niebezpieczeństwem śmierci. Dzieci chore, które są po pierwszej Komunii sw. też mogą przyjąć ten Sakrament. Zachęcamy wiernych by przyjęli ten Sakrament z wiarą i pobożnością.
