PALM SUNDAY PROCESSION



Holy Week will begin next week with
Palm Sunday on March 25. After the
blessing of palms, weather permitting,
we will process with our palms starting

at the west entrance of the church, then outside and around to
the Denison entrance, entering through the main doors.

Originally, people paraded or processed in the original footsteps
of Jesus from the little village of Bethany into the city of
Jerusalem. As part of the festivities they carried real palm fronds
or olive branches, the two most common trees in Palestine.
These were replaced with local versions of "palms" as the
celebration of Palm Sunday spread throughout Europe and then
the entire world: willow branches, cedar branches, pussy willows,
and flowers. The "palm branches" commonly used in the United
States are "ground palms" from Texas.

Before the beginning of Lent the following year blessed psalms
are burned and the ashes used in the Ash Wednesday ritual.
