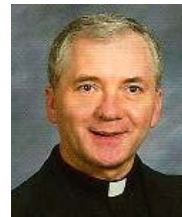

### FR. KNAPIK'S 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF ORDINATION



Fr. Andrzej (Andrew) Knapik is celebrating the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his ordination to the priesthood.

In 1972 he entered the Seminary in Tarnow, where he completed his philosophy and theology studies for the priesthood. On **May 28, 1978** the Most Reverend Jerzy Ablewicz, Bishop of

Tarnow, ordained Fr. Knapik a priest. He served as assistant pastor of several parishes in the Diocese of Tarnow and then in the newly established Diocese of Rzeszow, Poland. Fr. Knapik came to the United States in 1996. He was resident and assistant at St. Casimir Church in Cleveland. In 1997 he was appointed assistant pastor of St John Cantius Church. In 1998 he was transferred to Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish where he served for 16½ years.

When St. Barbara's was reopened in 2012 Fr. Knapik came on a weekly basis to preside at our Polish Mass from July 2012 to May 2013. In January of 2015 he was appointed assistant pastor of St. John Cantius Church and he returned to St. Barbara's to assist with the Ministry to our Polish speaking parishioners. Fr. Knapik has also served as Chaplain of University Hospitals in Cleveland since 2016.

God bless Fr. Knapik on his 40<sup>th</sup> Jubilee and belated good wishes to him for his birthday on May 24. **Sto Lat!**

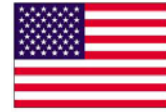

## Statement from the Most Reverend Nelson J. Perez, Bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland, on the Shooting at Santa Fe High School In Texas, May 18, 2018

Once again, our hearts are broken over the news of high school students and teachers falling victim to a young gunman's rage, this time in Santa Fe, Texas. We are overwhelmed with sadness over this latest incident of senseless violence and its resulting loss of innocent life. We grieve with those who lost loved ones and we ask God for healing for those who were injured.



I ask everyone of good will join together with me in prayer for the victims of this shooting and their families, for all the public safety responders and for the Texas communities stunned by this tragedy. May our witness of prayer and solidarity help move people to action leading to meaningful changes that promote school safety and the safety of all people, and encourage the building up of a culture of life. And may the God of all love and compassion bring consolation and healing in the wake of this horrible incident.
