CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION This Sunday

The feast of the Holy Body and Blood of Christ, popularly known by its Latin title, Corpus Christi ("Body of Christ") originated in the 12th century. It was introduced to the universal church in 1264. The Feast of Corpus Christi is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of



common faith and adoration. **This Sunday, June 3**, we will have our traditional procession to celebrate Corpus Christi after the 11:00 a.m. Polish Mass. Weather permitting, the procession will be outdoors at three altars prepared by parishioner families followed by benediction back inside the church. **All are invited to participate in the procession.**




CAN YOU FIT A WEEKDAY MASS INTO YOUR VACATION PLANS?
