CATHOLIC RENEWAL MINISTRIES' CONFERENCE

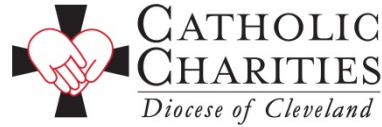
