Stations of the Cross ~ Let us all come together to pray the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m. the Fridays in Lent: March 3, March 10, March 17, March 24, March 31 and April 7. The Stations of the Cross is a Lenten devotion that offers witness by way of a spiritual pilgrimage to Jesus' Passion and Death in following his footsteps to the cross. Also known as the Way of the Cross, or as Way of Sorrows (Via Crucis, a street within the Old City of Jerusalem believed to be the actual path Jesus walked to Mount Calvary), the Stations originated in medieval Europe when wars prevented Christian pilgrims from visiting the Holy Land. It is a powerful way to contemplate, and enter into, the mystery of Jesus' gift of himself to us. We are renewed in this intimate experience of Jesus' solidarity with all humanity in our way of the cross each day.



FIX-UP CAMPAIGN: As of last Thursday, we had 54 donors to the 21st Century Fix-Up Campaign, who gave or pledged a total of \$ 31,455.00. That's enough to pay for the emergency repairs we already made to keep rainwater out of the church and school, plus a running start on the cost of a new roof on the older wing of the school. I'm confident that we'll be hearing from a lot of people who will provide donations for tuck-pointing all three buildings and painting the interior of the church.

In a related development, my 6-year term of office was supposed to end on July 1. I wrote the Bishop to ask for an extension, since it could be imprudent to change leadership in the midst of a campaign and major repair project. He agreed, and extended my term until July 1, 2018. He did not give me an entire new term, which I think is wise, because another 6-year term would almost take us to my 76th birthday. I would like to slow down before then. That gives us 17 months to finish our major maintenance projects as nearly as possible. I don't know what retirement will look like. Some of our retired priests who are physically able form a relationship with just one parish where they help with Masses, classes etc. as needed. Others "ride the range" and make themselves available wherever there is a need in any of the 19 counties of the Toledo Diocese. I think I would prefer the first option, have a church community that I could be part of and contribute to in a part-time way.

ALMOST LENT: Don't look now, but it is about 1½ weeks until Lent begins. Ash Wednesday is March 1. We will have Masses at 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. that day. We will offer a full set of Lenten opportunities: Stations of the Cross every Friday at 1 p.m. and 7 p.m., weekday Masses at 8 a.m. on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, as well as Tuesday at 6:30p.m., ecumenical services at different locations at noon on Wednesdays, and plenty of opportunities for God's forgiveness in Confession. "That Man Is You", "Seven Deadly Sins, Seven Lively Virtues," and "Walking with Purpose" will all be continuing.
