In 1990, in response to the growing number of St. Victor Vietnamese parishioners, Msgr. Stephen Perata encouraged the formation of the Vietnamese Catholic Association of St. Victor (VICA).

Parish contributions of the Vietnamese Catholic Association include participation in the annual parish festival, multicultural liturgical celebration of Pentecost, celebration of Vietnamese martyrs and assistance in the building of the new Parish Center.
