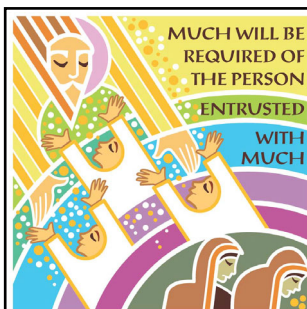

OUR FATHER IN FAITH

The Letter to the Hebrews today sings a hymn of praise to Abraham and to his faith, upon which are founded the religions of Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. Abraham is called "father" in faith by more people on earth than anybody else, numerous as the sands of the seashore or the stars of the heavens. Hebrews tells us it was this foundational faith that led Abraham to obey God's call when he heard it, though he was called to journey to a land he did not know and told he would father a mighty race through a marriage he thought was barren. But Abraham's faith, the author of Hebrews tells us, was his realization of what he hoped for, and the evidence of what he could not see. How often are we, in simple daily events of our own Christian vocation, called to an unfamiliar place or told we are to do something we do not believe we can? How fortunate we are to have Father Abraham as our guide and example!

Welcome Back World Youth Day Pilgrims For the first time in our St. Victor history, an organized group representing our U.n.I Lord Youth & Young Adult Ministry attended World Youth Day 2016 in Krakow, Poland. 24 pilgrims traveled to be immersed by the theme of WYD: "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy" - Matthew 5: 7. With this beatitude in mind, the endurance of physical sacrifice was overcome knowing that we trust in Jesus and He will bring us closer to the Kingdom of God. It was not an easy pilgrimage - on an average day, it was an 8+ mile walk to attend the various WYD events located throughout Krakow, be in awe of St. Mary's Cathedral, honor and respect the tomb of St. Faustina at the Divine Mercy Shrine, visit the "Have No Fear Shrine" of Blessed Pope John Paul II and especially the walking pilgrimage to the Campus of Mercy to attend the Vigil and Final Mass with Pope Francis. We became stronger as a family in Christ knowing that we had prayers with us from all of you at our parish. It will be an experience never to be forgotten and a teaching of our faith that will be with us for a lifetime. In the coming weeks, you will hear first-hand accounts from our pilgrims as they share their experience with the Parish.
