**This Week's Second Collection is for
ST. VICTOR TUITION ASSISTANCE FUND**

This fund provides limited financial assistance to a family whose children have been enrolled at St. Victor School for at least one year. These scholarships are awarded once annually, in the summer, to families who apply and meet the criteria. Parents must apply annually for this tuition assistance program. Financial Aid Forms are available in the school office.

DID YOU KNOW?

On the right side of the altar at St. Victor Church is a cross. The cross is made of African Mahogany and inlaid with white maple to reflect the diversity of our parish. This came about after the cross used in the hall in 2000, made of branches, needed to be replaced. The wood was found and a journeyman cabinet maker built the cross, including a long handle so it can be carried. A member of St. Victor's made the base the cross sits in. While the building process took time, the events of September 11, 2001 took place. A decision was made to dedicate the cross to the victims of the 9/11/2001 tragedy. A plaque is affixed to the base of the stand to reflect that. Father Candido Lim, blessed the cross before it went on the altar. It is just but fitting, to use this cross again in our altar, as together as one family in Christ, we pray for peace throughout this year.



On the ambo (pulpit), ever wonder what that wooden box is all about? This is our prayer box. Prayer petitions written on paper are put here for our community to pray about every Sunday: "and for all the intentions in our prayer box." On Easter vigil we collect all intentions written for the whole year and use it to light our Paschal Candle at the Easter Vigil.
