

Greetings!





Canon Law

Canon 1196 - In addition to the Roman Pontiff, the following can dispense from private vows for a just cause provided that a dispensation does not injure a right acquired by others: (1) the local ordinary and the pastor with regard to all their subjects and even travelers; (2) the superior of a religious institute of society of apostolic life if it is clerical and of pontifical right with regard to members, novices, and persons who live day and night in a house of the institute or society; (3) those to whom the Apostolic See or the local ordinary has delegated the power of dispensing.

This canon typifies the jurisdiction of the various authorities of the Church. The Pope respects and trusts his (arch)bishops who are also called to respect his authority. There are some things that the Pope supercedes and other things that he entrusts to his (arch)bishops. Similarly, the bishops also supercede pastors in some matters while entrusts other matters to the pastors of parishes in the respective dioceses. This stems from Jesus' empowering His Apostles at the Resurrection: "Those whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained" (John 20:23).

Readings For Next Sunday

We continue in our liturgical year and Lectionary cycle as we focus more on the Gospel of Luke. The readings for the 1st Sunday of Lent include:

First Reading:	Deuteronomy 26: 4 - 10
Second Reading:	Romans 10: 8 - 13
GOSPEL:	Luke 4: 1 – 13

As Jesus began His 40 days in the wilderness/desert, we not only begin our 40 days of Lent but we experience temptations throughout our earthly lives. What are our temptations? How do we avoid them? How do we strengthen ourselves against them? How do we help others avoid theirs'? Or are we more considerate of their privacy and feelings than we are for the health and salvation of their souls?

On Stewardship

During the Lenten Season we are especially called to almsgiving as works of charity and mercy cover a multitude of sins. Stewardship is found in both: almsgiving and the time sacrificed when we go to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We prioritize the need to improve and restore our relationship with God and to amend our lives over our earthly, selfish desires of our time management.
