Growing in Faith: What does the Resurrection mean for us?

Jesus' Resurrection—the most important event in human history—is how we know that what He said and did while on Earth is true and His promises to us are trustworthy. During His public ministry, Jesus spoke and acted as God. He promised that if we follow Him, we will have eternal life. Either He was God and had the power to make it true, or He was a mere man claiming to be someone He wasn't. That Jesus rose from the dead—a fact verified by more than 500 eyewitness accounts—means that His word can be trusted. He warned of the specifics of His own death, predicted His Resurrection, and proved that He really is God. Therefore, His promises of eternal life are real, too. The Resurrection gives us hope. "By His death, Christ liberates us from sin; by his Resurrection, He opens for us the way to a new life." (Catechism of the Catholic Church #654). All those who die in God's friendship will live with Him forever.
