


## Sixteenth Annual Prayer Breakfast

JOHN GARVEY

Our keynote speaker is John Garvey, President of The Catholic University of America. Mr. Garvey is a nationally recognized expert in constitutional law and the First Amendment and his remarks will center upon religion and religious liberty. He is the author or coauthor of a number of books, including Religion and the Constitution (2011), Modern Constitutional Theory (2004, a popular law school textbook in its fifth edition) and What are Freedoms For? (1996). Garvey has twice given testimony to the United States House of Representatives on issues of anti-Semitism (2013) and religious liberty (2012). Previously, Garvey served as dean of the Boston College Law School (1999-2010) and as a professor of law at the University of Notre Dame and the University of Kentucky. While Assistant to the Solicitor General of the United States Department of Justice, Mr. Garvey argued several prominent cases before the United States Supreme Court, including Silkwood v. Kerr-McGee Corporation. He continues to be a prominent public voice in the national debate of many contemporary issues in higher education, religious liberty, culture, law, and Catholicism. Garvey's writing has been published in numerous mainstream news outlets and he has appeared on major news networks, including ABC, CBS, Fox, PBS, MSNBC, CNN, National Public Radio, and BBC. Born and raised in Sharon, John is a 1966 graduate of Sharon High School. He obtained his undergraduate degree from the University of Notre Dame and is a graduate of the Harvard Law School. Garvey and his wife, Jeanne Walter Garvey, have five children and 20 grandchildren.
