PRO-LIFE MINISTRY

This Tuesday, December 12, is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The Blessed Mother, under the title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, is the Intercessor of the Unborn. To help stop the anti-life push in the world the late Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen encouraged the spiritual adoption of an unborn child. This is done by praying that one particular but unknown child's life be spared abortion and be allowed to continue to live. To help accomplish this, it was recommended, an individual say the following daily prayer for a period of nine months.

"Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion."

The name I wish to give my baby is:_____. During your earthly life this spiritually adopted Child of yours will be known only to God but in the world to come it is hoped that you will meet the souls your prayers saved and spend eternal happiness with them.

(Also, the suggestion was made to adopt your baby on December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, to help you remember when you started your adoption prayer. After nine months for the next three months then pray that your baby was saved and that he/she is happy and healthy in a loving home. Next December 12 adopt a new baby and continue praying.
