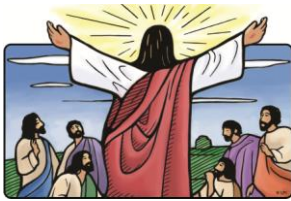

# Religious Education Update

There certainly has been a lot going on in religious education and faith formation at St. Matthew's! But, the dust barely settles from one activity before we're on to the next--and that's a blessing! I'd like to update the parish on three items – **First Holy Sacraments**, **Vacation Bible School**, and **Family-Based Catechesis**.

**First Holy Sacraments!** As listed by name in the May 7<sup>th</sup> bulletin, there were **61 of Jesus' disciples** who received their first Holy Sacraments (Baptism, Reconciliation, Eucharist, and/or Confirmation) during the Lenten and Easter seasons. The St. Matthew community continues to offer our prayers of praise and thanksgiving as we continue our pilgrimage on our own faith journey along with these faithful. We also offer our **thanks to** all the families, sponsors, friends, teachers, catechists, and the many assistants who were key to supporting these disciples as they more closely encounter Jesus through His sacraments.

**Vacation Bible School (VBS).** This summer St. Matthew's families will have the opportunity to attend VBS as we are partnering with St. Mary's Church in Bellevue. VBS will be **Monday, 26 June to Friday, 30 June 2017** at St. Mary's School. The program will be fun-filled and its theme is "The Makers Fun Factory. Created by God. Built for a Purpose." You can find the **sign up information** on the **St. Matthew's website** (see below) under the "**VBS**" tab. Make sure you indicate your parish is St. Matthew's on the registration form. We are also looking for adult and youth **volunteers** to assist with VBS. If you're interested in being a volunteer, please let me know. Also, volunteers can watch the website for continually updating information relevant to them. In the long-term we plan to continue working with St. Mary's to have fun and exciting VBS opportunities—to include alternately hosting VBS between St. Mary's and St. Matthew's parishes. Please watch for future bulletins announcing sign-up opportunities after weekend Mass. Or, go to the website to register now.

**Family-Based Catechesis (FBC).** The St. Matthew's "**Wednesday Night**" RE program is transitioning next fall to a FBC program. The FBC model of religious education is based on the Catholic teaching

that "**Parents are the primary educators in the Faith.**" In FBC, a core team catechizes the parents or guardians of our parish youth. This catechesis occurs during a once-a-month 75-minute session. The catechized parents then go forth provided with two home lesson plans to cover as a family during the month. The goal is to increase the faith formation of entire families, not "just" the children. This then also helps build-up the faith life of the entire parish. While the primary participants of FBC is projected to be the Wednesday night RE youth and families, parishes implementing this model have found it fruitful to offer it to the entire parish, i.e. the 5-day school families, empty nesters, single parishioners, etc. In other words, the once-monthly group teaching session is **open to the entire parish!** The program we're choosing is based on the Catechism of the Catholic Church. This will be a **great opportunity for parish adult faith formation as well as our parish youths' formation.** Please watch for a future bulletin announcing **Information sessions** about this exciting new program.

## Special Gifts—Updated

Thank you to those who have already generously donated funds to the needs below.

The following items could not be funded through the annual budgeting channels because of the limited amount of revenue generated in a year. These items remain needed and hopefully a parishioner or group of parishioners might be interested in funding one or more privately. The estimated cost of each item is provided. Funding of any item would be much appreciated. Please contact the Parish Office if interested. Thank you.

1. Install electronic marquee on 36<sup>th</sup> Street. (est. \$15K) The marketing of St Matthew to the thousands of people who pass by on 36<sup>th</sup> Street each day would be extremely beneficial to the parish. Payback would come in welcoming new parishioner families, additional participation in fish fries, generating more students for the school, etc. It could be our billboard to others as well as a source of information to our own parishioners. **Fund is up to \$400. An ongoing silent auction fundraiser is underway. POC Scott Eversole**
2. Replace/repair windows in the Rectory (\$15K) This is a required maintenance item but would also contribute to lower utility bills.
3. Add cabinets & soundproofing to Reconciliation Room (est. \$7.5K) Privacy should be assumed in this room! As our population ages, speaking sometimes becomes louder and can be heard outside the current room. In addition, storage is badly needed for valuable items left in the room.
4. New siding for the Rectory (est \$15K) This is a normal maintenance item for an aging house. The current siding has deteriorated to the point that birds are nesting in the siding.
5. Video kiosks at both entrances to Commons to improve communications (est. \$5K). Kiosks would help communication with parishioners and keep everyone informed of upcoming events, special occasions, status of fundraisers, etc. (Might be included as a package deal with item 4 above.)
6. Repair/resurface entire parking lot (est. \$100K) The parking lot needs a complete overlay after years of spot maintenance and badly deteriorating asphalt. It would send a message of pride to visitors to our parish as well as provide a much safer surface to walk upon.
7. Rebuild domain and Windows server for School (\$9500)
8. **Fully Funded and project completed** Fireproof Storage Cabinet for official Parish Records (est. \$400)
9. **Partially Funded~2 classrooms completed** Classroom Lighting update for efficiency (est. \$24K) Upgrading the classroom lighting would enhance the learning experience and reduce utility bills
10. **Fully Funded and project completed** Carpet for Rectory
11. **Repainting donated + \$1,000 Funded for Future Replacement** New statues of Mary & Joseph The current statues have been moved back and forth for storage so many times. As a result, the St. Joseph statue is now beyond repair. These are focal pieces for our weekend liturgies and should convey reverence.
12. **Fully Funded and purchased** New Baptismal Font *The new font is located in the chapel.*
13. **Fully Funded and completed** Repair concrete
14. **Fully Funded and completed** Repair front walk that has settled by 6 inches at Rectory
15. **Fully Funded and completed** Replace carpet in Chapel area *Check out the new carpet in the chapel, it looks great! Also, thanks to our Minutemen for repainting the entire chapel area, reconciliation room and sacristy.*
16. **Fully Funded and completed** Gravel overflow parking areas *Gravel and barriers have been installed, we now have additional parking! Thank you to the Knights, Minutemen and all who contributed physically and financially.*
