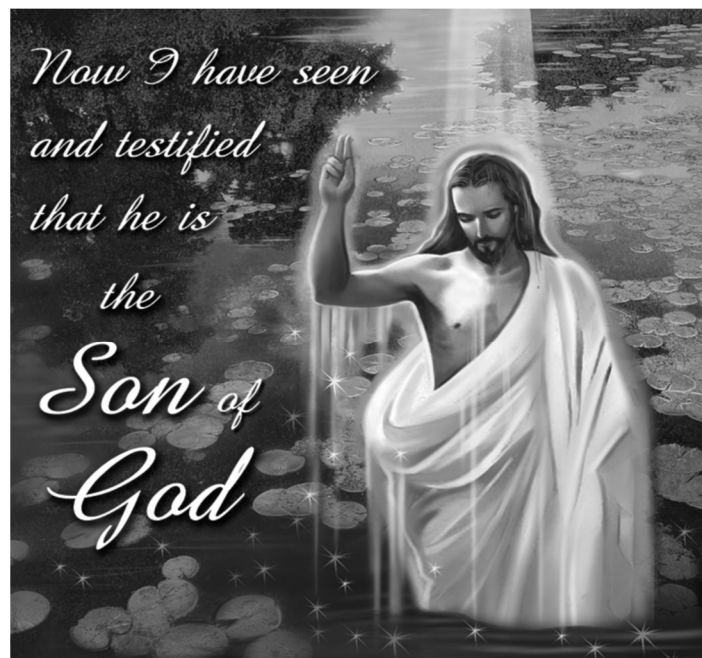

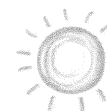

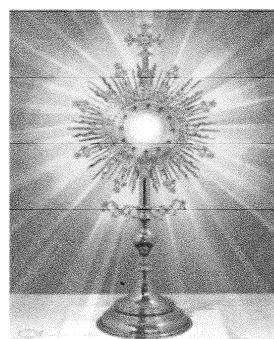

Safeguard the Children
Reading between the lines

When children express that something is wrong at school or with other activities, it's often the job of caregivers to read between the lines to determine what's really going on. They might say, "I'm bored" and need your guidance finding a better school-life balance or engaging in more challenging academic work. Ask them to give examples to help you understand what is actually going on. If the child is still being vague, remind them that they can tell you anything and that you'll listen with an open mind. As parents and caregivers, you have the opportunity to help kids deal well with negative feelings and challenges. If they are being mistreated in some way, keeping an open line of communication with kids will enable you to be their advocate. ***To Parents of our Young Children,
May we Suggest...***

Relax! God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome. Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going on. They tire of seeing the backs of other's heads!

Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, ushers, choir, etc. Sing hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying.

If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me." Remember, that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church of God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of God.

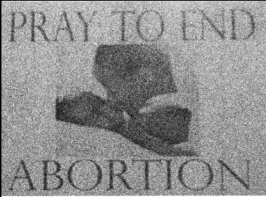

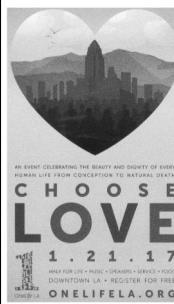

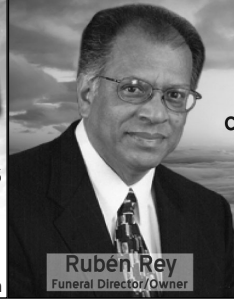
