Relax! God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome. Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going on. They tire of seeing the backs of other's heads!

Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, ushers, choir, etc. Sing hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying.

If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me." Remember, that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church of God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of God.

Fr. Patrick was born in Alhambra, CA and attended St. Vincent's High School Seminary in Montebello, CA. After high school Fr. Patrick attended St. Mary's Novitiate in Santa Barbara, St. Mary's Seminary in Perryville, MO and De Andreis Institute of Theology in Lemont, IL. Fr. Patrick was ordained in 1975 for the Congregation of the Mission. From 1975 to 1979, Fr. Patrick was on the faculty of St. Vincent's High School Seminary where he taught and was Vocation Director for the Vincentians. Following this assignment Fr. Patrick was assigned to St. Vincent's in Huntington Beach, CA for two years; Miraculous Medal in Montebello, CA for four years; and, St. Vincent's in Phoenix, AZ for ten years. From 1995 to 2001, Fr. Patrick was on the staff of DePaul Evangelization Center in Montebello, CA and from 2001 to 2016 was director of St. Mary's Seminary while helping out with Masses at San Roque Parish and helping as a chaplain at Bishop Diego High School.

Fr. Patrick also conducts recovery retreats for those in 12-step programs. Fr. Patrick enjoys photography and has enjoyed helping out as a docent and photographer at the Mullin Automotive Museum in Oxnard, CA.

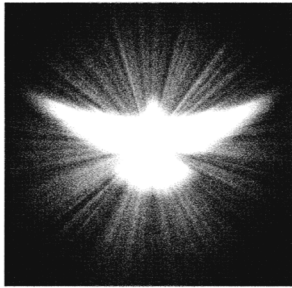

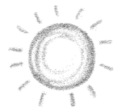

Although it may be awkward to approach a parent you do not know, if you have witnessed a scenario where the child is in danger of physical or mental abuse, it is your responsibility to act in that child's best interest. In addition to reporting concerns, think about any practical solutions that can help keep kids safe pending an investigation and solution. 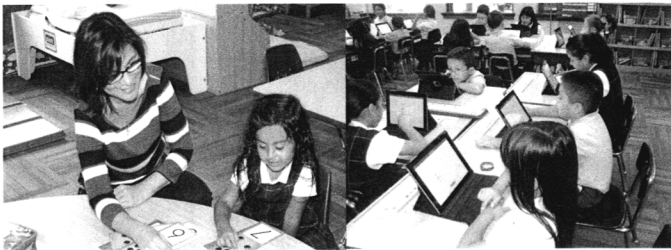

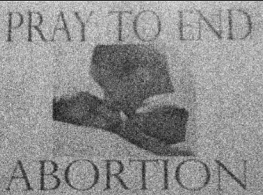

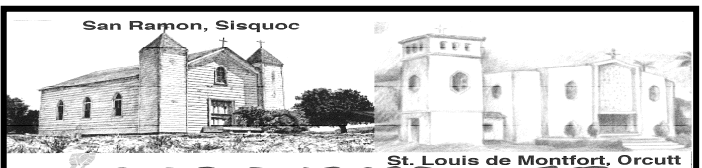
