Lenten Regulations

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 yrs. and older on *Good Friday*, and on all the *Fridays of Lent*.

Fasting is to be observed on *Good Friday* by all Catholics 18 yrs. of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

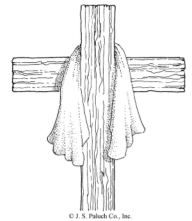
Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

Electronic dating violence is prevalent among teens

Teenagers do a lot of communicating online and via mobile devices through social media and texting. Entire relationships can be shaped formed over the internet and messaging, and the private nature of these relationships may make it easy to hide signs of abuse and violence. Dating violence means any act of mental, emotional or physical aggression among a couple sharing an intimate relationship. Online, these acts are harder to pinpoint, especially for adult outsiders whose children may be victims of emotional dating abuse. 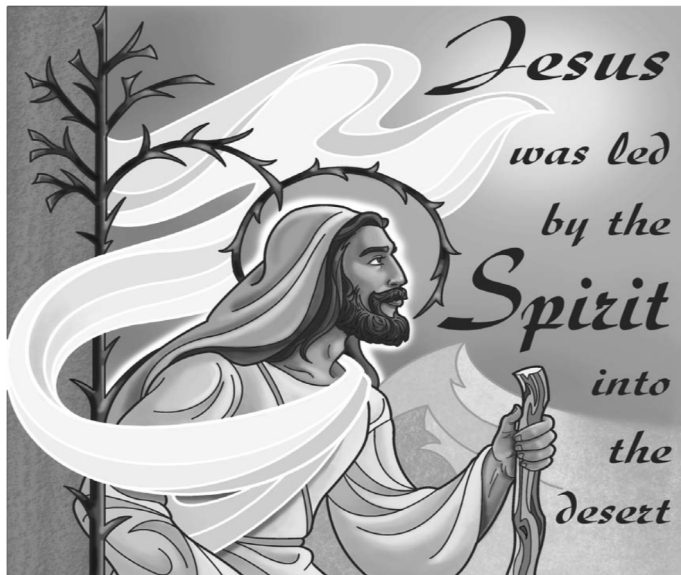

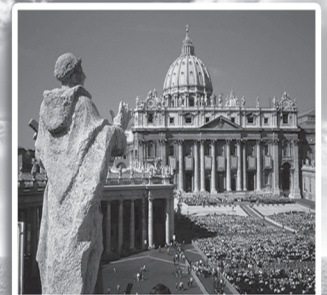
