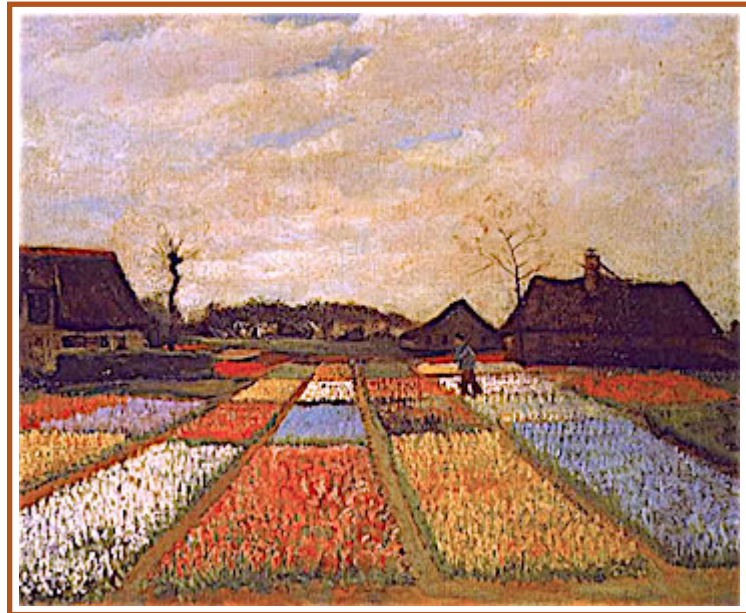

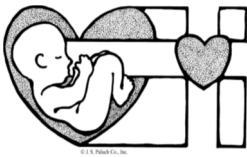

From the Pastor...



As we approach the Lenten season we will make choices about what we will give up, sacrifice, or do. In my reflections over the last few months I have found much for which to be grateful. One of these is the liturgy here at San Roque. We are blessed to have a dedicated and talented Music Director, an excellent choir, and talented cantors who work hard to provide music that both speaks to us and draws forth from us.

This Lent I invite all of us, in addition to your individual Lenten practice, to reflect on our understanding of and our role in the liturgy.

There is a “catch-22” in our having such quality music all the time in that we might, consciously or not, “let the choir/cantor do it.” The congregation singing and responding is central to the character and structure of liturgy whether at Mass or other liturgies. We sing the Mass. Music is not an add-on but essential. The choir and cantors aid the congregation in participating. They do not replace.

If you have attended Catholic weddings and funerals have you experienced a difference between those with music and people singing and those that do not? When a congregation sings, when people respond the experience is richer and deeper.

Music should lead us to that “full, conscious and active participation in liturgical celebrations which is demanded by the very nature of the liturgy. (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy #14)

You will notice at Mass I am always singing with everyone. I cannot sing on my own as can other priests (I have my own scale) but I will always sing with others. If you and I can sing Happy Birthday with others we can sing together at Mass. Try it for Lent and as our voices are joined see the church roof rise a bit.

Lenten Regulations

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 yrs. and older *on Good Friday, and on all the Fridays of Lent.*

Fasting is to be observed *on Good Friday* by all Catholics 18 yrs. of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

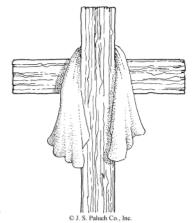
Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

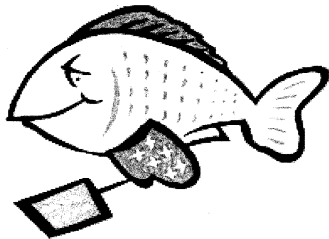
