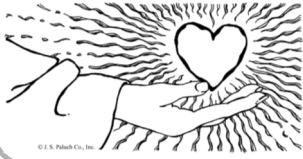

### Lenten Regulations



**Abstinence from meat** is to be observed by all Catholics 14 yrs. and older on *Good Friday, and on all the Fridays of Lent.*

**Fasting** is to be observed on *Good Friday* by all Catholics 18 yrs. of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

**Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.**
