Lenten Regulations



Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 yrs. and older on Good Friday, and on all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting is to be observed on Good Friday by all Catholics 18 yrs. of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

From the Pastor...



More thoughts on the Sunday Liturgy

This week I want to focus on the Liturgy of the Word. The proclamation of the Scriptures is an essential and central part of our celebration. The structure and rhythm of the readings are familiar to us: a reading from the Hebrew Scriptures (apart from the Easter season), a sung Responsorial Psalm, a reading from the New Testament, and a Gospel reading.

The Scriptures are proclaimed and illuminate our communal past, present, and future. Why proclaim the readings? When something is proclaimed (spoken with dignity and respect) something happens, both to those who listen and to the one who proclaims. We notice different tones and emotions. We capture phrasing and meanings we miss otherwise. We have a sense of connection that goes beyond ourselves. We are more fully engaged.

This Lent I invite and encourage you to familiarize yourself with the readings ahead of time, during the week if time permits, or even a few minutes before Mass. Then, I ask you, during Mass, to put down the missalette, resist the temptation to follow along, ahead or behind and listen attentively. (If you have a hearing difficulty, please feel free to use the missalette.) Do this through the Sundays of Lent and see what a difference active listening makes in the celebration, and in you.

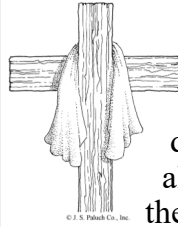

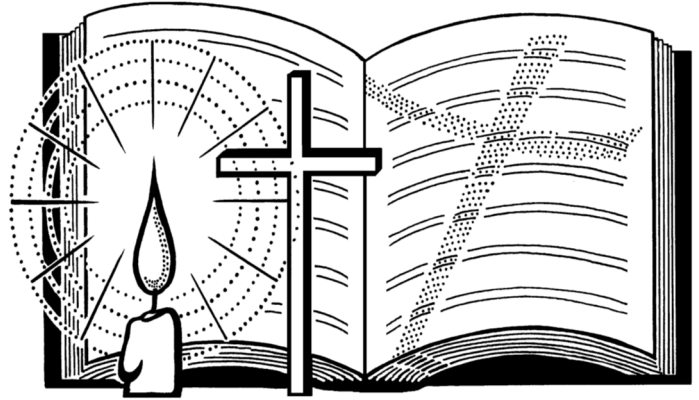

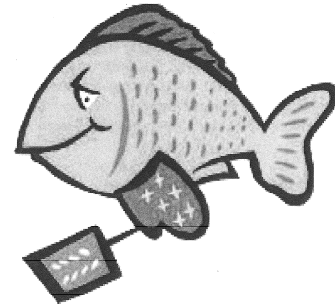
